

Cisco's Visit to the Thermal

The world's leading networking systems company Cisco's executives visited the Mayor of Yalova's office. Among the visitors where the president of the Cisco Foundation Michael Yutrzenka, the company's regional director Zika Abzuk and the Youth for Habitat Organization's general secretary Başak Saral. The group's courtesy visit to Mayor Barbaros Binicioğlu also included a visit to the Neighborhood Information Center, which was established through a partnership between Cisco and the Yalova Municipality.
