APP ADOPTION – One Economy has developed a Social Innovation Lab aiming to encourage software developers to create “public purpose” apps for the web and mobile devices. The apps are intended to help citizens find jobs, housing, homework help, and healthcare information—“things that fundamentally impact people’s livelihood,” One Economy’s David Saunier told Morning Tech.

One Economy is using a sliver of its \$28 million federal stimulus grant (the largest BTOP grant awarded) to fund the project to help make relevant content available to non-Internet users, particularly low-income and minority communities that are more likely to access the web via cell phones. The nonprofit plans to hold at least two contests for app developers, though the apps are not limited to building off public data sets like other similar app contests. More info <http://bit.ly/Cpiq>
