### **Tax preparation service offered**

Free tax preparation services are being offered for low-income residents in the Yuma area.

Certified tax return volunteers will help individual taxpayers who made less than \$15,000 in 2008 and families earning less than \$40,000.

Through April 5, the services will be offered Wednesdays and Saturdays from 5 to 8 p.m. at the Yuma Private Industry Council in Somerton, 201 N. Bingham Ave.; Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the Fernando Padilla Community Center, 800 Juan Sanchez Blvd.; Saturdays at the Martin Luther King, Jr., Neighborhood Center, 301 W. 13th Ave.; and Mondays and Tuesdays from 9 to 5 p.m. and Saturdays from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. at Goodwill, 1600 S. 4th Ave.

Residents should bring identification, Social Security cards for all family members, proof of income to include W2 and 1000 forms, documentation of deductible spending, accounts and routing numbers of checking and savings accounts, plus last year's tax returns.

The service is provided by United Way of Yuma and the Yuma Earned Tax Credit Coalition through funding provided by the Wal-Mart Foundation and One Economy.
